- June 23 Entrain, 6:00pm-8:00pm.** Epic in sound and kaleidoscopic in vision, the eclectic Martha's Vineyard based six piece Entrain has been thrilling critics and fans alike since it's inception. Entrain has recorded seven albums, available on Dolphin Safe Records, all of which have been praised for their ability to shift effortlessly between musical styles – from rock, blues, calypso and ska, to zydeco, jazz and funk – often within the same song.
