EVENT: The Exeter Parks & Recreation Department invites you to spend a day in Holderness, NH at the Squam Lakes Natural Science Center. The wild animals are ambassadors of their species, here for the purpose of educating our visitors about New Hampshire's natural world. Most are orphaned, injured, or otherwise unable to survive in the wild. Observing these animals up-close, together with experiencing our hands-on exhibits, offers visitors the opportunity to develop a deeper understanding of our native wildlife and appreciation of the natural world. Through spectacular live animal exhibits, natural science education programs, and lake cruises, Squam Lakes Natural Science Center has educated and enlightened visitors for over forty years about our natural world.

DATE: The date selected is Wednesday, May 23, 2012. We depart the Recreation Center parking lot at 8:30am for the trip to Holderness, NH and we will be returning to Exeter approximately 3:30pm.

COST: The cost for this trip includes transportation in the Recreation Department Van. Lunch will be on your own at "Walter's Basin Restaurant".

RESIDENTS/NON-RESIDENT: \$25.00

DEADLINE: The deadline to register is Friday, May 11, 2012 or once the van is filled.

Note: We need a minimum of 8 people registered. Maximum of 13 people.

GUIDELINES: Registrants must sit in the same seat(s) on the return trip as they sat in on the first part of the trip. If you have a need requiring you to sit in a particular area, please let the Recreation Office know when you register for the trip. The staff will relay to the trip escort that he/she needs to be sure you get the necessary seat. **Parents** are expected to have complete control of their children at all times throughout the trip.

Exeter Parks & Recreation Department sponsored trips are designed to provide members of the Exeter Community - families, friends, and individuals alike - with safe, relaxing and enjoyable sports and entertainment experiences.
