TOWN OF EXETER SUBSIDIZED TAXI PROGRAM

On Monday, July 7, the Board of Selectmen approved the implementation of the taxi voucher program. Under the program, residents over the age of 60 will purchase a packet of 20 vouchers for \$10. The provider, Academy Taxi, will then turn the vouchers in and will be reimbursed dollar for dollar. The program is 50 percent subsidized by the town.

To reintroduce the program, the town will purchase 25 books of \$1 vouchers using the senior citizens transportation budget.

The voucher books will be available at the Parks and Recreation Department during the above business hours. Those who are unable to pick up tickets can mail a request to the department with a self-addressed-stamped envelope to the Exeter Parks and Recreation, 32 Court Street Exeter, NH 03833. Checks are to be made payable to: E.P.R.D. (Exeter Parks & Recreation Dept.)

The program started in 1973 as a way for Exeter Senior Adults to go shopping, to the Doctor and visit family within town limits of Exeter. At the present time Exeter does not have any grocery stores so the town allows the tickets to be used to go shopping in Stratham's two grocery stores.

The program is not intended to take care of all your transportation needs as it is a supplemental program but it is a place to help you get around.

Note: * As tickets are for Exeter Senior Citizens only, Age 60 and over a valid proof of birth date and residence may be requested.
