

Exeter Transfer Station

Contact: DPW 773-6157

Location: Cross Road, Exeter, NH

Directions: From the bandstand head out of downtown on Front Street. Front Street (Rte 111) changes to Kingston Road.

Continue on Kingston Road (Rte 111) to Cross Road. Turn right onto Cross Road.

Transfer Station will be approx. ¼ mile on left. **Stop for Attendant!** The attendant must check vehicles and bags to ensure no hazardous waste is discarded at the Transfer Station. No Permits, Bags or Stickers sold at Transfer Station.

Transfer Station Rules:

To enter the Transfer Station you must be an Exeter resident or a property owner in the Town of Exeter and must have proper identification. For Exeter residents, a valid driver's license and for property owners, a tax bill is required.

Items that can be dropped off at **no cost with proper ID include:**

- used oil (in clear or semi-clear container with tight fitting lid such as plastic milk jug),
- leaves & grass (no plastic bags!)
- books, videos, CD's, DVD's - "Got Books"
- clothes & shoes - "Planet Aid"
- calculators and cell phones.

A **Transfer Station Permit** is required for disposal of the certain items. The permit can be purchased at Town Office only. You must show proof of residency or property ownership. License plate number is required for calendar year permit. It shall be affixed to the driver's side, lower corner of automobile windshield.

The following items require a Transfer Station Permit:

White Goods (non Freon appliances including washers, dryers, dishwashers, stoves, water heaters, etc.)

Metals - two metal containers

- **Ferrous:** steel, cast aluminum, tin, iron, wrought iron, bicycles, metal lawn furniture, metal barbecue grills, etc. (lawn mowers, snow blowers & other equip. accepted only if oil and gas removed.)
- **Non Ferrous:** aluminum, copper, brass

Wood, brush, wood pallets - no larger than 4' in length, no painted stained or pressure treated wood, no particle board, T-111 or plywood. Tinsel, lights and ornaments must be removed from Christmas trees.

Ash - wood stove and coal ash

Batteries - the following batteries should be taken to the Transfer Station or Household Hazardous Waste Collection; Lithium, Button Cell, Nickel-Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH), Lithium Ion (Li-Ion), small sealed lead acid (Pb) less than 2 lbs in weight and automobile batteries (check- some auto/parts may pay small amount for auto batteries)

Recyclable Materials - moving and other large boxes, newspaper, magazines and other paper products, glass food and beverage containers, aluminum, steel and tin cans, aluminum foil, plastic food and beverage containers #1 thru #7.

Household Trash - must be in "Town of Exeter" blue bags. Only household trash in Exeter blue bags is accepted in the regular dumpsters.

Freon Appliances

Items that have Freon require a **\$7 Freon Appliance Sticker and a Transfer Station Permit**. Freon Stickers are available at the Town Office. Freon appliances include:

- Refrigerators (remove doors)
- Freezers (remove doors)
- Air Conditioners
- Water Coolers
- Dehumidifiers

Note: non metal parts (bins, shelves) must be removed and placed in "Exeter" blue bag and disposed in Construction Debris Container.

Electronic Waste

Electronics contain lead and a variety of other hazardous materials.

Electronic items require a **\$10 Electronic Waste Sticker**, but *do not need a Transfer Station Permit*. Electronic waste includes:

- Computers & accessories (monitor, hard drive, printer, laptop, etc) each piece requires a separate sticker
- Televisions
- Copy machines, Fax Machines, Scanners
- Microwave Ovens
- Stereos, Radios, DVD & VCR players
- Toaster Ovens, Coffee Makers, Digital Alarm Clocks
- Vacuum Cleaners, Electronic Scales, Fans

Construction Debris

(implemented Fall 2008)

A "Pay-as-you-Throw system has been established to provide residents a way to dispose of small quantities of construction debris. A "Town of Exeter – Orange Bag and Sticker" program allows Exeter residents to dispose of items such as drywall, shingles, & insulation. These items can be placed in the "Orange Bag" or items such as doors, windows, toilets, sinks, and bundled wood or carpet can use an approved "Orange Sticker". Cost is \$6.00 per bag and \$6.00 per sticker. Bags and stickers may be purchased at Town Office and at Arjay's Ace Hardware. A Transfer Station permit will be needed to dispose of construction debris.

NO ASBESTOS!

Mercury Disposal

As of January 1, 2008, all products containing mercury are banned from landfills and incinerators.

Items that may contain mercury and should be taken to the Transfer Station include:

- Thermometers, thermostats, electrical switches, mercury button cell batteries and fluorescent light bulbs including compact fluorescent bulbs.
- Items containing mercury can also be taken to the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day, held the 1st Saturday in October.
- Arjay's Ace Hardware accepts a limited number of fluorescent bulbs and mercury containing thermostats, contact store for more information.

ITEMS THAT CANNOT BE ACCEPTED AT TRANSFER STATION:

- **Bulky Waste** (one item per week *with sticker* may be placed at curbside on regular trash day)
- **Household Hazardous Waste** (Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day is held the 1st Saturday in October)
- **Propane or Gas Tanks** (Propane tanks may be taken to the Raymond Transfer Station-\$5)
- **Tires** (Raymond Transfer Station \$5 & up)
- **Antifreeze, Brake Fluid or other Auto Chemicals** (Dispose at Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day)



CURBSIDE BULKY TRASH PICK-UP

The Town of Exeter contracts with Northside Carting for our bulky trash pick-up. Each week 1 (one) bulky item is allowed curbside with a bulky item sticker attached.

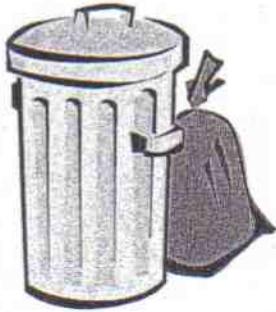
Also available at Public Works Monday thru Friday 7:00AM – 3:30PM

The following rules apply:

- Item must be curbside by 7:00AM on your regular trash day with your blue bag trash.
- Item must have a Town of Exeter disposal sticker attached to the item.
- Items that will be picked up include but not limited to: Furniture, tables, chairs, mattresses, box springs, sofas, recliners, bureaus, area rugs (rolled & tied), etc.
- Item must be of a size and weight that can be handled by two workers.
- Items that can be disposed of at the Transfer Station will NOT be picked-up curbside.

Items that will NOT be picked-up curbside include, but not limited to the following: (If you have an item you are not sure if it is acceptable for pick-up, call Public Works at 773-6157.)

- No yard waste - leaves, grass, brush.
- No refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, humidifiers or dehumidifiers.
- No washers, dryers, dishwashers, stoves, trash compactors.
- No fluorescent light bulbs, compact fluorescent bulbs.
- No oil, gasoline, gas and oil mixture, gas tanks, antifreeze or car batteries.
- No metal items.
- No water heaters.
- No lawnmowers/snow blowers.
- No cardboard boxes or items in cardboard boxes or plastic bins.
- No televisions, stereos, VCR's, DVD players, radios, vacuum cleaners, electronic scales, microwave ovens, toaster ovens.
- No computers, monitors, printers, fax machines, scanners, copy machines.
- No items containing mercury.
- No tires, hazardous waste or flammables.
- No construction debris (sheetrock, shingles, paint or stain of any kind, wall to wall carpeting, toilets, tubs, sinks, etc).
- No propane tanks.

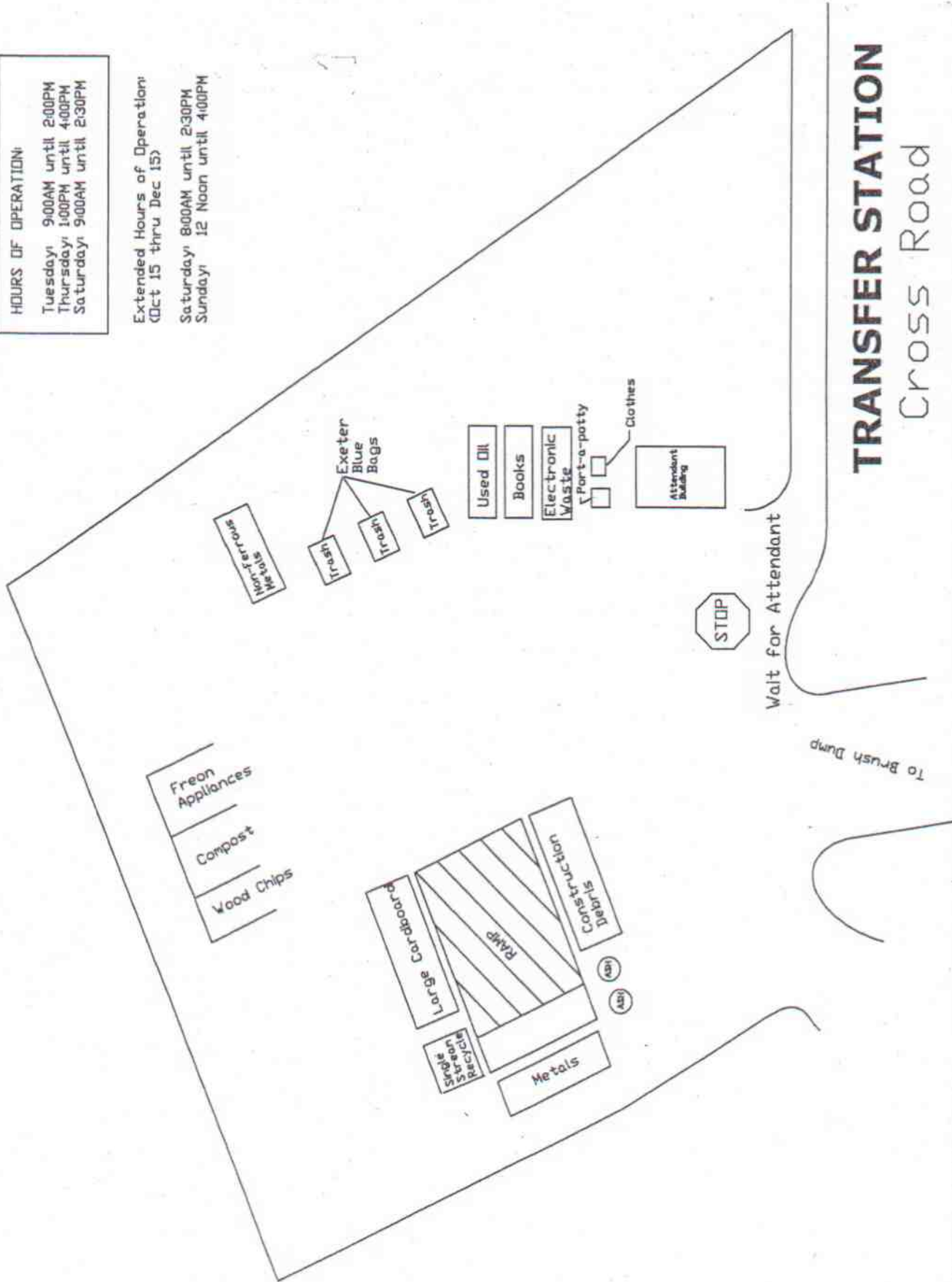


TRASH DISPOSAL TIPS

- Curbside disposal is limited to use of Town of Exeter blue plastic bags.
- Blue bags must be left curbside, must be readily accessible & easily handled and tied.
- Weight limit per bag is 45 pounds.
- Bags/containers MUST be curbside by 7:00AM on your scheduled pick-up day.
- Bags/containers may NOT be placed curbside prior to 24 hours before your collection day.
- **Effective June 2, 2008, you may place one bulky item with a bulky item sticker curbside each week with your blue bag trash.**
- **NO HAZARDOUS WASTE!** Hazardous waste must be stored until future hazardous waste drop off day!
